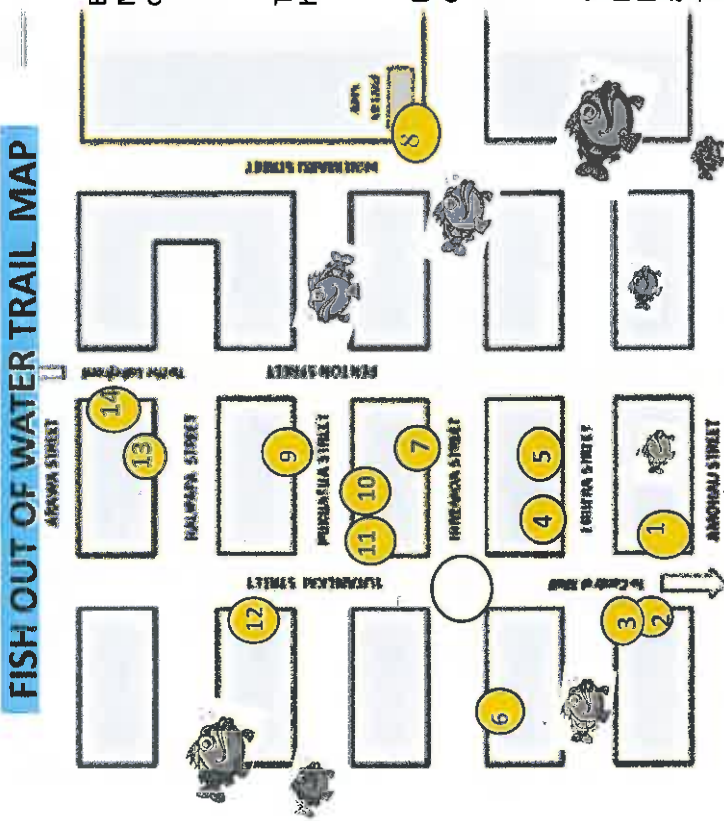


# FISH OUT OF WATER TRAIL MAP
